


## **PROGRAM INCOME**

Total Income for Space of Her Own: \$108,682

In-Kind Total: \$67,000

Total Expenditures for Space of Her Own 2020-2021 Fiscal Year: \$ 157,459



#### **VOLUNTEERS**

Our outstanding volunteer mentors pivoted with us during this pandemic, attending group Zoom meetings and connecting one-on-one with their mentees via phone, Facetime and, with their masks on, during socially distanced walks.
